- Scholarships may be renewed for awardees for additional academic years when requirements are met.* Includes maintaining a minimum 2.5 scholastic standard. Awardee is responsible to send report card transcript every year to reapply.
* Future award amounts may vary.
- Awardees may seek additional scholarships for post-graduate work.
